<u>Acquisition of Property</u>: The Contractor shall document that abperty was acquired consistent with its engineering, production planning, and property control operations.

<u>Receipt of Government Property</u> The Contractor shall receive Governmproperty and document the receipt, record the information necessary to mteet record requirements of paragraph(1)(iii)(A)(1) through (5) of this clause, identify as Government owned in a manner appropriate to the type of property (e.g., stamp, tag, mark, or other identification), and manage any discrepancies incident to shipment.

- (A) Government-furnished property. The Contractor should lish a written statement to the Property Administrator containing all relevant facts, suzshcause or condition and a recommended course(s) of action, if overages, shortages, damages and/or other discrepancie discovered upon receipt of Government-furnished property.
- (B) Contractor-acquired property. The Contractor shall take all actions necessary to adjust for overages, shortages, damage and/or other discrepanciess velised upon receipt, in shipment of Contractor-acquired property from a vendor or supplier, stoas nsure the proper adability and allowability of associated costs.

<u>Records of Government property</u> The Contractor shall create and main**taic**ords of all Government property accountable to the contract, inding Government-furnished a@ontractor-acquied property.

- (A) Property records shall enable a complete, curredttable record of all transactions and shall, unless otherwise approved by the Property Administrator, contain the following:
 - x The name, part number, and description, National Stock Number (if needed for additional item identification tracking and/or disposition), and ortblata elements as necessary and required in accordance with the terms accordance of the contract.
 - x Quantity received (or fabricated) sued, and balance-on-hand.
 - x Unit acquisition cost.
 - x Unique-item identifier or equivalent (if available and necessary for individual item tracking).
 - x Unit of measure.
 - x Accountable contract number or equivalent code designation.
 - x Location.
 - x Disposition.
 - x Posting reference and date of transaction.
 - x Date placed in service (if required in accordawith the terms and conditions of the contract).

(B) Use of a Receipt and Issue System for Governtink/material. When approved by the Property Administrator, the Contractor may maintain, in lieu of formal property records, a file of appropriately cross-referenced documents evidencing receipt, iassoleuse of material that is issued for immediate consumption.

Physical inventory. The Contractor shall periodically perform, record, and disclose physical inventory results. A

- x Property is delivered or shipped from the Contractor's plant, under Government instructions, except when shipment is to a subcontractor or other location of the Contractor; or
- x Property is disposed of in accordance with paragraphs (j) and (k) of this clause.

Utilizing Government property:

- (A) The Contractor shall utilize, consume, move, and store Government Property only as authorized under this contract. The Contractor shall promptly disclose and report Government property in its possession that is excess to contract performance.
- (B) Unless otherwise authorized in this contract otheyProperty Administrator the Contractor shall not commingle Government material with material not owned by the Government.

<u>Maintenance</u> The Contractor shall properly maintain Government property. The Contractor's maintenance program shall enable the identification, disclosure, and preance of normal and rouge preventative maintenance and repair.
